50. WINDOW WANDERLAND

Member received a proposal from Inspire All to work with them on a new project called Window Wanderland.

The project involves residents to decorate their windows with creative designs.

The Town Council would hold a competition for the best window submitted.

It was AGREED:

- (i) to work with Inspire All on the project, with Inspire All paying for the registration fees and The Town Council paying the prize money;**
- (ii) The prize be set at £200; and**
- (iii) To feature the winning design in the next Town Crier.**

It was AGREED:

- (i) to create a Virtual Christmas Decoration display similar to the summer Virtual Flower Display and have them on display at various locations around the town;**
- (ii) to support the Chanukah social distance event taking place in the Borehamwood Shopping Park; and**
- (iii) to support and advertise The Elstree Mozart Players concert taking place at Allum Hall on 2 December.**
