78. COACH TRIPS

It was noted that the Council planned to continue to run a programme of coach outings to various seaside and countryside destinations for qualifying residents aged 60 or over each summer (during June and July). This service commenced in 1988 and continued to be a success and very popular with residents. Whilst only a small number of completed feedback forms were received at the Council Reception Desk, these indicated high levels of satisfaction with the service and a desire for it to continue.

It further noted that new destinations were considered each year with up to 900 people taking the opportunity to have an affordable day trip. Ticket prices would remain at £7, as previously agreed by the Committee, in 2016/17 and were available only to eligible Elstree and Borehamwood residents (and carers).
