34. MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

The Minutes of the meeting of the Committee held on 6 September 2016 were approved and authorised for signing by the Committee Chairman.

35. COMMITTEE BUDGET 2017/18

36. FIREWORKS NIGHT

Members received a progress report on arrangements for organising the 5 November 2016 Fireworks Display on Meadow Park.

It was noted that all arrangements for this event had now been completed insofar as this was possible to do so (including obtaining stewards, the issuing and obtaining of proper licenses, permissions, risk assessments, insurance(s) and police and traffic notifications).

Hertfordshire Constabulary had assisted with the preparation of the Risk Assessment for the event. It was noted that whilst policing priorities were not within the Council's direct control, every effort had been made to ensure that adequate numbers of PCSOs, Specials and regular Officers would be available on 5 November 2016, especially as the event fell on a Saturday.

It was noted that no charity collections would be permitted at the Fireworks Event due to the suitability of the environment and nature of the event for this purpose.

37. CHRISTMAS 2016

Members congratulated the Events Officer for securing another celebrity booking to switch on the lights this year (following on from *EastEnders* star Shona McGarty in 2015); namely, Dame Barbara Windsor DBE.
