60. REPORT OF THE EVENTS COORDINATOR

The report of the new events coordinator was received. It was noted that:

Jubilee Tattoo

- The Events Coordinator was still liaising with Pastor David Jackson of the Lutheran Church to organise the Queen's Diamond Jubilee Cadet Tattoo to be held at Allum Hall on Sunday 12 February 2012 at 3pm c.4.30pm;
- It was noted that the event included a bagpiper, PA system and bunting with seating for c.250. Representatives of the Scouts, Army, Air and Sea Cadets

together with the British Legion would present the afternoon and be inspected by the Lord Lieutenant of Hertfordshire.

Following discussion surrounding the Queen's Diamond Jubilee Cadet Tattoo to be held at Allum Hall it was RESOLVED that:

whilst it was noted that the budget for Council contribution to the Tattoo be from the New Initiatives vote (3147/301), premises hire costs be allocated to the Civic Festival Premises Hire vote (3241/302).

- (i) local schools be invited to comment on proposals for a Guy Fawkes competition for the 2012 Fireworks Night, with assistance (if required) to be offered by Cllr R Butler; and

It was AGREED that:

local schools be contacted (via Head Teachers/Governors) to ascertain interest in including a float for the 2012 Civic Festival Parade, with details being provided of possibilities for contributory funding, ideas for themes or any other assistance to be provided by the Town Council to increase participation.
